They purchased the wine barrels in October, 2006, filled them with soil and planted them with Camilla trees, hardy violas and bacopa (Snowstorm White). They also planted a variety of daffodil bulbs. Everything they planted was perennial, so the barrels would always be blooming. In the barrel that was planted to the right of the entrance to the building they also hung a rabbit sculpture that is meant to represent Scotty.
