

El Dorado County 4-H Horse Camp Camp Packing Lists

Please use this check list to ensure that you bring everything you will need for camp.

Packing List for Campers

- Sleeping bag, pillow and pad/cot. You will be on cement floor so think comfort.
- Toothpaste and toothbrush, soap, shampoo and towels.
- Hair brush and any other grooming aids (deodorant, hair ties, etc.) ***No blow dryers or curling irons are permitted.***
- Enough jeans, socks, underwear and shirts for 4 days of riding.
- Short pants, bathing suit, sweatshirt or light jacket.
- Riding boots, tennis shoes for when you are not riding. ***No sandals are permitted.***
- Sunscreen, Chap Stick, bug spray.
- Medication must be in properly labeled bottles and **will be kept with the camp director.**
- New or clean halter if you want to paint it and clean white shirt for tie dye project

Packing List for Horses

- Large water bucket (size of a muck bucket). Hay bag or bucket if needed.
- Minimum of two bags of shavings. Camp will provide some shavings amount known by mandatory camp meeting July 22nd at 7:00pm at the fairgrounds.
- Halter and a lead rope
- Saddle, saddle pad and bridle
- Vet Supplies, vet wrap, antibiotic ointment, gauze pads
- Fly spray
- Pitch fork, muck bucket or wheel barrel for cleaning stalls
- Feed for your horse that they are used to eating. Camp is not a good time to change diets. Something to consider, grass hay feed throughout the day can help with boredom of stall life.
