

El Dorado County 4-H Horse Camp Camp Rules

The following guidelines are designed to make your experience as a 4-H member at Horse Camp a pleasant one for you and for all others attending. This means that all participants: 4-H members, leaders, and staff, shall respect the individual rights, safety and property of others.

1. Campers will be under the supervision of camp staff at all times.
2. Campers will stay within the camp boundaries while at the fairgrounds.
3. Campers are not allowed in the barn area unless under staff supervision.
4. While in the barn area campers must be in boots, no tennis shoes or sandals.
5. When leading a horse, helmets will be worn from the time you leave your horse's stall until you return your horse to the stall.
6. No riding on pavement. You are to ride in the arena and outside dirt warm up area only. There must be a Camp Staff member present before mounting your horse.
7. No camper may leave an area by themselves. Campers must inform staff and have staff accompany them to destination.
8. Camp is to be a safe place to expand your horsemanship skills. There will be no teasing, bullying or any form of behavior that would cause harm to another camper or their horse.
9. In the event that a camper is unable to follow the rules they will be sent home.
10. Camp staff reserves the right to send a horse home if it is a danger to it's rider or others.
